Seguin Island Light Station Camping Policy

Camping is permitted during the Seguin operating season from Memorial Day through Columbus Day with RESERVATIONS ONLY. Membership is required. Reservations are accepted beginning May 1st each year through the FOSILS office at 207-443-4808, in person, or by e-mail at keeper@seguin island.org. The suggested donation for renting the campsite is \$10/night per person.

FOSILS has the final authority for accepting reservations. All money and reservations will be handled through the Seguin office.

What campers can expect for a stay on Seguin Island.

Seguin is a remote island 2 ½ miles out to sea accessible only by boat. Island visitors are rewarded with spectacular views of Maine's mid-coast while experiencing Seguin's beautiful natural environment and unique history. Guided tours of the light house and first order Fresnel lens are presented by the seasonal caretakers.

Tenting is allowed only in the designated picnic area off the cove trail.

No open fires allowed on the island

Transportation: You are responsible for making transportation arrangements. FOSILS website and office have information about transportation options.

Cancellation: If your stay is cancelled for uncontrollable circumstances, your donation can be refunded or applied to a future reservation.

Water: All drinking, cooking and bathing water must be brought by campers. Drinking water is NOT provided nor available on Seguin.

Sanitation: Campers will use the composting toilet near the bottom of the tramway. All regulations posted in the outhouse must be followed. All articles brought on to the island must be carried off. There are no trash cans provided.
